Procedures for Providing Information for Interested Persons with Disabilities Concerning the Existence and Location of its Accessible Programs, Services and Activities

- I. In accordance with the United States Department of Justice/Civil Division/Disability Rights Section, Loudon County Government hereby establishes the following policy:
 - a. Interested persons with disabilities requesting information regarding the existence and location of its accessible programs, services and activities may do so by contacting the ADA Coordinator (Leo Bradshaw 458-4663).
 - b. The ADA Coordinator will post on the official Loudon County, Tennessee website the following statement as the official notification of this policy:

In accordance with the "Settlement Agreement Between The United States of America and Loudon County, Tennessee Under the Americans With Disabilities Act DJ204-70-67, Paragraph 22", Loudon County requests that all questions regarding accessible programs, services and activities be directed to the ADA Coordinator, Leo Bradshaw at (865) 458-4663. Furthermore, the only programs, services and activities directly provided by Loudon County are County Commission, Workshop, and Committee meetings.
