The Lost Vets is a local charity run by local volunteers. Our Homeless Ministry helps those veterans who have either been unable to adapt to living in society or through circumstances beyond their control become homeless. We also lend a helping hand to veterans who are not homeless but still need us. This is a partial listing of the help we provide: food, money for medicine, rent or other necessities, transportation to medical appointments and sometimes the most important thing is time and caring and love.

Mr. Willie Franklin founded our charity and there have been times he has had a call in the middle of the night to go talk someone out of suicide. PTSD is a continuing problem for these veterans. Sometimes they are only just out of high school when enlisting, they've gone from living in a structured environment at home to a structured environment in the service—albeit a totally different structure. Still, they are part of a larger family, a larger community of people to talk to, vent to, share stories with. Then, they come home to a situation where they are completely responsible for themselves. Add to that the sad fact of reality in the service that they might have had to take lives, they might have seen things we cannot imagine, they might have had to DO things contrary to their nature—then you have a recipe for a hard adjustment back to civilian life.

The Lost Vets has a bigger dream for these valiant warriors. We want to open a Tiny House Village in Loudon County. An ideal setting would be approximately 15 tiny houses complete with an onsite mentor. Each veteran would be responsible for his/her house and the community would be responsible for setting their corporate rules/laws/enforcing. Counselors would come to treat those with PTSD, anxiety disorders, etc. There would be representatives from the VA to help with getting benefits started as well as social workers to help with other benefits. There are people on the lookout for land but we need money for supplies, land, etc.


