Sheriff James D. Davis II and the Loudon County Sheriff's Office hosts a *Citizen's Law Enforcement Academy* for Loudon County residents twice a year (spring and fall – dates to be announced). This series of classes is free of charge and taught by law enforcement professionals volunteering their time to share their expertise. Class openings are limited and require a background check. <u>We ask you be</u> prepared to commit one evening for eleven (11) consecutive weeks (at 6:00 PM) once our schedule is set. Successful graduates will receive a certificate of completion at their graduation ceremony.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the academy is to provide citizens with a basic understanding of training and requirements for their local law enforcement officers and to foster a cooperative partnership between our citizens and the officers who serve them.
