Dear Mr. Fritts:

Please allow this letter to serve as the Report of Compliance that the Office of Open Records Counsel (hereinafter "OORC") is required to issue in accordance with Tenn. Code Ann. Section 8-44-109(c). On April 8, 2010, the OORC reviewed and approved the final version of the proposed Loudon County, Tennessee Commission Forum Plan (hereinafter referred to as the "Plan") and the "Terms of Use Agreement" that the Loudon County Commission submitted as part of its plan for use of an internet forum. The content of both the Plan and the "Terms of Use Agreement" describes the manner in which the Loudon County Commission intends to ensure compliance with Tenn. Code Ann. Section 8-44-109. Based upon all of the documentation received, the OORC has determined that the proposed plan and actions substantially comply with the law and as such, the Loudon County Commission is now allowed to establish or utilize an internet forum.


This Report of Compliance is conditioned upon the terms that are set out in the Plan and the terms set out in the "Terms of Use Agreement."

The OORC issues this Report of Compliance based upon the abovementioned conditions and pursuant to the provisions of Tenn. Code Ann. Section 8-44-109. If the Loudon County Commission does not agree with any of the statements expressed herein, please notify this Office within five (5) business days of receipt of this Report.

The final decision to permit this type of communication between members of the Loudon County Commission is solely the responsibility of the officials of the Loudon County Commission. A representative for the Loudon County Commission must notify the OORC within five (5) business days subsequent to the establishment of the forum. Similarly, the OORC must be notified within five (5) business days if the Loudon County Commission decides not to proceed with the forum referred to in this Report. If the forum is

established, and it is thereafter determined that use of the forum will be discontinued, notice must be given to both the OORC and to the public. Failure to fulfill any of these ongoing responsibilities with respect to the forum will render this Report of Compliance null and void.
